Code of Conduct for Senior Playing Members

All Senior Playing Members of Worthing Cricket Club will abide by the following:

- Play in the team for which they have been selected. Selection will be made by the Chairman of Selectors, with advice from captains and selection will be based upon performance, availability and reliability.
- If a player is unsure of the reasons for being dropped, he/she must arrange a time to talk with the Chairman of Selectors or anyone else involved in team selection.
- Teams will be selected by the Wednesday of the week leading up to a Saturday fixture.
- Player subscription to Worthing Cricket Club will be paid no later than May 31st of the season for which it is relevant
- Match fees will be paid on the day of the game to the club member who is collecting money for the team
- The Player will inform the selection committee of his/her availability for a game as early as possible - preferably at least one week in advance.
- Players will avoid dropping out of a match after Wednesday of the week of that match.
- Players should do their utmost to attend any club events, understanding that member support for these events is what allows the club to make cricket available to all members of the club through fund raising.

Senior Playing Members include all senior players, aged 18 or over, participating in league, friendly and training activities run by or in association with Worthing Cricket Club and use of its playing facilities
